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Matthew 13:44 KJV

(44) Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto treasure hid in a field; the which when a man hath found, he hideth, and for joy thereof goeth and selleth all that he hath, and buyeth that field.

The hidden treasure, the Kingdom of God, is within every one of us. We can discover it only by seeking it with all our strength and resources. The Father is looking for His sons to return to Him and rejoin Him, submitted to Him as His children, living as family members with Him in His household, and enjoying the privileges of provision and righteousness.

This story shows that every one of God's sons has everything the Father has, but it also shows that the pigpen is not where it is received. We must go to the Father in Jesus' name, submit ourselves to Him, and be reinstated as family members, activating every provision that is ours.
